Constitution Of India.

No.GP/19/2019/GHS/102014/1399/T:- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of all the rules made in this behalf, the Governor of Gujarat, hereby makes the following rules to provide for regulating recruitment to the post of Medical Officer, Class II, in the Gujarat Health and Medical service, under the Commissionerate of Health, Medical Services and Medical Education and Research, Gujarat State, namely:-

1. These rules may be called the Medical Officer Class II, in the Gujarat Health and Medical Service Recruitment Rules, 2019.
2. Appointment to the post of Medical Officer, Class II, in the Gujarat Health and Medical Service shall be made on the basis of the result of the competitive examination held for the purpose.
3. To be eligible for Appointment on the basis of the result of the competitive examination held for the purpose to the post mentioned in rule 2, the candidate shall,-

- (a) not be more than 35 years of age ;

Provided that the upper age limit may be relaxed in favor of the candidate who is already in the service of the Government of Gujarat in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967;

- (b) possess a Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (M.B.B.S) degree obtained from any of the Universities established or incorporated by or under the Central or a State Act in India; or any other educational institution recognised as such or declared to be deemed as a University under section 3 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956; or any other equivalent qualifications specified in the First or Second Schedule to the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956;


- (c) possess the basic knowledge of computer application as prescribed in the Gujarat Civil Services Classification and Recruitment (General) Rules, 1967, and
 - (d) possess adequate knowledge of Gujarati or Hindi or both.
4. The candidate appointed on the basis of the result of the competitive examination held for the purpose, shall be on probation for a period of two years.
 5. The candidate appointed on the basis of the result of the competitive examination held for the purpose shall, during his probation period, be required to undergo pre-service training and pass the post-training examination in accordance with the provisions of the Gazetted Officer's Pre-service Training and Examination Rules, 1970.
 6. The candidate appointed on the basis of the result of the competitive examination held for the purpose shall, during his probation period, be required to pass the qualifying examination for computer knowledge in accordance with the provisions of the Gujarat Civil Services, Computer Competency Training and Examination Rules, 2006.
 7. The candidate appointed on the basis of the result of the competitive examination held for the purpose shall, be required to pass an examination in Hindi or Gujarati or both in accordance with the rules prescribed by the Government.
 8. The candidate appointed on the basis of the result of the competitive examination held for the purpose shall be required to get himself registered with the Medical Council of Gujarat, under the Gujarat Medical Council Act, 1967 at the time of appointment if he is not so registered.
 9. The candidate appointed on the basis of the result of the competitive examination held for the purpose shall if so required be liable to serve in any defence service or post connected with the defence of India for a period of not less than four years including the period if any spent in training:

Provided that such a candidate,-

- (a) shall not be required to serve as aforesaid after the expiry of ten years from the date of his appointment;
- (b) shall not ordinarily be required to serve as aforesaid after attaining the age of 45 years.

10. The candidate appointed on the basis of the result of the competitive examination held for the purpose shall be required to undergo such training and pass such examination as may be prescribed by the Government.
11. The candidate appointed on the basis of the result of the competitive examination held for the purpose shall be required to furnish a security and surety bond in such form for such amount and for such period as may be prescribed by the Government.
